

**NOTICE OF 30 –DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
7<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND MISSOURI AVENUE  
HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE SITE LISTING**

Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is proposing to list 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Missouri Avenue on the ADEQ Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site registry pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute §49-287.01.

The 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Missouri Avenue in Phoenix is bounded to the north by East Montebello Avenue, to the south by East Georgia Avenue, to the west by North 6<sup>th</sup> Street, and to the east by North 10<sup>th</sup> Street. The boundaries described are intended to provide the public with the basic information regarding the estimated geographic extent of the currently known contamination. The actual extent of the contamination may differ; therefore the geographic boundaries may change as new information becomes available. The contaminants of concern are tetrachloroethene and trichloroethene.

The site score is 42 out of 120. The site score is based upon a review of available information regarding the presence of hazardous substances at the site. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare or the environment.
