

## PROPOSED TERMINATION OF APPROVED CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice that a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) is being considered for termination under Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-12-263.02(J). The CAP contained a proposal to demonstrate proposed corrective actions would be protective of public health, welfare and the environment for the following site:

ADEQ has decided to terminate the CAP based on the following rationale:

1. Corrective action standards outlined in A.A.C. R18-12-263.03 and R18-12-263.04 were not met within the timeframe outlined in the CAP.
2. Site conditions have changed and the approved remedial options in the CAP are no longer applicable.

If a public meeting is to be held, ADEQ will schedule and notify the public in accordance with A.A.C. R18-12-264.01(A) of the meeting time and location.
