



**TECHNICAL REVIEW AND EVALUATION  
OF THE HOT MIX ASPHALT PLANT GENERAL PERMIT REVISION**

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Hot Mix Asphalt Plant (HMAP) General Permit is a permit for a facility class (concrete batch plants) that contains 10 or more facilities that are similar in nature, have substantially similar emissions, and would be subject to the same or substantially similar requirements. The General Permit was renewed on February 26, 2014 and is in effect for five years.

**II. REVISION DESCRIPTION**

The General Permit is being revised during its 5 year term to incorporate:

**A. Online Submittals (myDEQ)**

Once the myDEQ portal becomes available, permittees will be required to submit all compliance certifications and move notices online. Conditions regarding these submittals contain “trigger language” which maintains the current condition until the portal is available, and the new requirement is triggered.
