This report is updated Monday through Friday and is valid for areas within Pinal County, Arizona

Saturday 5/27/2017 MODERATE	Winds: Light winds becoming west 5-12 mph Stagnation: Early morning stagnation
Sunday 5/28/2017 MODERATE	Winds: Light winds becoming west 5-10 mph Stagnation: Early morning stagnation
Monday 5/29/2017 MODERATE	Winds: Light winds becoming east to southeast 5-15 mph in the morning, eventually becoming west during the afternoon/early evening switching to an easterly wind late evening 5-15 mph Stagnation: Early morning stagnation
Tuesday 5/30/2017 MODERATE	Winds: East to southeast 5-15 mph, gusts 20-25 mph early, becoming southwest to west in afternoon/evening 5-15 mph Stagnation: No stagnation
Wednesday 5/31/2017 MODERATE	Winds: Light becoming southwest in afternoon 5-15 mph, gusts 20-25 mph Stagnation: Early morning stagnation

Synopsis & Discussion

Quiet weather on tap for this holiday weekend as high pressure builds into the area. The winds will subside after today and be relatively trivial through the first half of Memorial Day. A pressure gradient will set up near the four-corners and result in breezy easterly to southeasterly winds late Monday and lasting into Tuesday. The five day forecast period has all moderate dust risks with the Hidden Valley area being the area of highest PM10 levels.



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
