Issued: Friday, December 2, 2016

Five-Day Weather Outlook:

A couple of upper level low pressure systems are expected to impact the forecast area Saturday and early next week. They will bring breezy winds along with the possibility for some spotty areas of blowing dust, but little if any precipitation at most locations. However, the overall PM10 levels are expected to be relatively low, mainly due to the recent rains. Therefore the five day dust risk forecasts remain in the low category. Check back on Monday for an updated forecast.
