NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality received the above-referenced application on September 24, 2013. As stated in your cover letter this application is a stand alone representation of the current status of the proposed project and supersedes all previous submittals. ADEQ's review of this application is subject to the requirements of the licensing time frames ("LTF") statute under Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") § 41-1072 through § 41-1079 and the LTF rules under Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R18-1-501 through R18-1-525.

Per A.R.S. § 41-1074, ADEQ has determined your application is administratively complete. This determination ends the Administrative Completeness Review time frame and begins the Substantive Review time frame for your application. Any substantive deficiencies in your application will be noted in a separate written request for additional information.

Pursuant to A.A.C. R18-2-330, a public notice of receipt of the complete application will be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where your facility will be located. Additionally, pursuant to A.A.C. R18-2-330, as part of this application process, the public will be provided an opportunity to review and comment on the draft permit during a 30-day public participation period. That public notice will be published in two newspapers of general circulation in the county where your facility is or will be located. ADEQ will process the public notice requirements and arrange for publications with the Arizona Range News and the San Pedro Valley News. ADEQ requires Bowie Power Station, LLC to pay each newspaper directly for costs associated with the public notice publications, and will provide the payment details at the appropriate time. ADEQ is informing you of the public notice requirements early in the permitting process to ensure that payments or payment arrangements are made before each newspaper's deadline.

A.A.C. R18-2-330 also requires that Bowie Power Station, LLC post the public notice at the site where the facility is or will be located, in a prominent location under Bowie Power Station, LLC legal control, adjacent to the nearest public roadway, and visible to the public using the roadway. The sign should be

posted beginning on the first date of publication and is required to remain for 30 days until the public notice period ends. Enclosed are the public notice sign posting requirements to provide you with sufficient time to prepare. When the public notice publication dates have been selected, ADEQ will provide you with the public notice legal document which will contain the posting dates.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Sign shall be 3-feet wide by 4-feet high.
2. Bottom of sign shall be 18 inches above the ground.
3. Sign shall be supported by two anchor posts.
4. Sign shall be posted on the affected property in such a manner as to be legible from the public right of-way.
5. Sign shall be black letters on a white background.
6. Sign shall be made of 1/4-inch plywood.

You will need to post a copy of the Public Notice adjacent to the nearest public roadway on the property where your facility is or will be located. This notice posting should conform to the Public Notice posting requirements.
