The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division, has completed its review of the referenced permit application.

I am prepared to recommend that your Air Quality Control Permit be issued with conditions necessary to meet all rules and regulations applicable to this source related to air pollution control. A draft of the Permit with appropriate conditions is enclosed for your review.

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statute §49-426.D, a Public Notice will be issued in the **Sierra Vista Herald** and the **San Pedro Valley News-Sun** on November 2, 2005 and November 9, 2005 and will give instructions for making comments and an opportunity to request a Public Hearing on the Permit. A copy of this Public Notice is also enclosed.

**You will need to post a copy of this Public Notice adjacent to the nearest public roadway on the property where your facility is located.** This notice posting should conform to the attached Public Notice posting requirements. The notice should be posted from the date of first publication to December 2, 2005.

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **YOU HAVE A VOICE IN AIR POLLUTION CONTROL IN ARIZONA**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue Air Quality Control Permit Renewal Number 36937 to Cochise County Department of Facilities and Solid Waste Management for the continued operation of a Municipal Solid Waste Landfill located ½ mile north of SR 82 and four miles east of SR 90 in Cochise County, Arizona.

This Public Notice provides information to help you participate in the decision-making process. You have an opportunity to submit written comments on this Permit, and request that ADEQ hold a Public Hearing on the Permit. The written comment shall state the name and mailing address of this person, shall be signed by the person, their agent or attorney and shall clearly set forth reasons why the permit should or should not be issued. Grounds for comment are limited to whether the Permit meets the criteria for issuance spelled out in the State Air Pollution Control laws or rules.

Materials related to the Permit, including the application, ADEQ's analysis and the draft permit are available for your review at ADEQ's office at 1110 West Washington Street in Phoenix, Arizona and at the Town Clerk's Office at 500 North Gonzales Boulevard in Town Clerk of Huachuca City, Arizona 85616.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or request a Public Hearing have until December 2, 2005 to do so. Comments and/or requests should be directed to: Director, Air Quality Division, ADEQ, 1110 West Washington Street, 3415A-1, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

ADEQ will consider all comments received in making a final decision on the proposed Permit. Everyone commenting will receive notification of the final decision. People who file comments on the Permit will have the right to appeal the final decision as an appealable agency action to the Office of Administrative Hearing (OAH) pursuant to §41.1092.03, and the appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of the final decision. The OAH may sustain, modify, or reverse the final decision.

Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation such as a sign language interpreter, by contacting Linda Morrison at (602) 771-4793 TDD phone 771-4829. Requests should be made as early as possible to allow time to arrange the accommodation.

Your request should also state that you wish your name to be placed on the Air Quality Permit mailing list.

### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Sign shall be 3-feet wide by 4-feet high.
2. Bottom of sign shall be 18 inches above the ground.
3. Sign shall be supported by two anchor posts.
4. Sign shall be posted on the affected property in such a manner as to be legible from the public right of-way.
5. Sign shall be black letters on a white background.
6. Sign shall be made of 1/4-inch plywood.
