ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PUBLIC HEARING ON THE INCORPORATION OF CODIFIED RULES INTO ARIZONA STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (SIP)

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) will hold a public hearing to receive comments on the incorporation of codified rules into the Arizona Applicable SIP. Consistent with the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes §§ 49-104, 49-404, 49-406, and the Code of Federal Regulation, Title 40, §§ 51.102 through 51.104, and Appendix V to part 51, revisions to Arizona's SIP must be submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) by the director of the ADEQ on behalf of the governor. The following rules are included: 1997 National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS), Office of Administrative Hearings, Article 7 Technical Amendments, Dispersion Techniques Definition Revision, Mineral Tailings Rule Change, and the Repeal of Appendices 10 and 11.

A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, at 2:00 p.m. at 1110 W. Washington St, Phoenix, AZ 85007, Room 145.
