STAKEHOLDER MEETING ~ COMMENT PERIOD ~ PUBLIC HEARING
EPA Revised National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for Nitrogen Oxides

ADEQ will hold a **stakeholder meeting on Thursday, December 2, 2010, 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., Room 145 at ADEQ**, 1110 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ, to explain and take questions on the revised NAAQS for nitrogen oxides (NO₂). A 30-day comment period will begin December 3rd, ending with a **public hearing on Tuesday, January 4, 2011, 4:30 p.m. in Room 145 at ADEQ**. All interested parties will be given an opportunity at the public hearing to submit relevant comments, data, and views, orally and in writing. The public comment period will end at close of the public hearing.

On November 12, 2010, a letter from EPA was sent to Governor Brewer stating that Arizona will be recommended as “unclassifiable” for the revised standard due to insufficient monitoring data. Each county will be recommended for separate unclassifiable status to avoid a statewide impact to the Prevention of Serious Deterioration (PSD) program. No factor analysis or different boundaries will be necessary.
