### 2008 Inspection Updates

As we approach the new year, remember to update your inspection criteria. Most 2003 and older vehicles must be inspected after Jan. 1, 2008 and original equipment alternative fueled vehicles 2005 and older must be inspected. ### Clean Air Fleet Award

Over the years there have been numerous fleets which have performed their duties as expected. While there have been some the department has had to take to task for serious infractions or repeated failure; there have been those who are a pleasure to work with; whose records are always in order and who have worked diligently with their staff to excel. Each fleet recognized will receive a "Clean Air Fleet Award" certificate, and be listed here as well as on the ADEQ Web site. We will attempt to photograph fleet agents and inspectors as certificates are awarded, and get them on the Web site. The criteria for the "Clean Air Fleet Award" are:

- 5 years as a fleet entity (minimum)
- 5 year clean record (no serious violations), and
- Clean inspector record
