

## **STATUS OF REMEDIAL PROGRESS**

Since access to the State Assurance Fund (SAF) will terminate on July 1, 2010; ADEQ is continuously reviewing the current status of leaking UST (LUST) sites that have an approved corrective action plan (CAP) or approved pre-approval work plan (PAWP). ADEQ is interested in assisting UST owners, operators and volunteers in ensuring that remediation of their leaking LUST site is progressing in a timely and effective manner.

Owners, operators, and volunteers can contribute to this process by coordinating with their environmental consultant to review the progress of remedial activities at the LUST site. If, after the review is complete, the UST owner, operator, or volunteer determine that a modification to their approved CAP may be appropriate or a new PAWP may be needed, please contact ADEQ. UST owners, operators, and volunteers might also determine that their remedial efforts may be at the stage where confirmation sampling of the soil and/or groundwater is warranted to document eligibility for LUST case closure.
