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## **CONTINGENCY PLAN**

### **C.1. Introduction**

#### **C.1.1. Purpose**

This plan is designed to minimize hazards to human health or the environment from fires, explosions, or any unplanned sudden or non-sudden release of hazardous waste or hazardous waste constituents to air, soil, or surface water. This plan is intended to produce full compliance with Title 18, Chapter 8, 264.A and Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 264.601, 264.603, and 262.34 (a) (4).

#### **C.1.2 Scope**

As of January 2010, all of the manufacturing operations at the UPCO PAZ facility have been relocated to the UPCO facility in Fairfield, California. All buildings and associated equipment have been removed. The provisions of this plan will be carried out immediately whenever there is a fire, explosion, or release of hazardous waste or hazardous waste constituents, which could threaten human health or the environment.

#### **C.1.3 Description of Facility Operator**

UPCO, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Goodrich Corporation, is located in Fairfield, California. The UPCO facility address and the mailing address of the California facility are identified as:

### **C.2. Incident Response**

In the event of a release, fire or explosion involving hazardous waste or hazardous materials or to a situation that poses the risk of such an occurrence, the Emergency Coordinator (ERC) will quickly assess the situation and direct, in a timely manner, measures to control the emergency and protect human health and the environment. The ERC will contact the appropriate emergency service contacts and regulatory agencies identified in Table C-1.

### **C.3. Amendments to the Contingency Plan**

This plan will be reviewed and amended as required by R18-8-264.A (40 CFR 264.54). The following conditions require plan revisions:

- Regulations are revised which affect facility activities;
- The plan fails in an emergency;
- The UPKO facility changes in a way that materially increases the potential for fires, explosions, or releases of hazardous waste or hazardous waste constituents or changes in the response necessary in an emergency;
- The list of Emergency Coordinators changes.
