The Town of Payson invites you to participate in recycling at the several recycling sites around town. Why recycle? It's good for the community, saves landfill space, and preserves our natural resources.

You can recycle paper, cardboard, and newspapers at six Payson drop-off sites; plastics and tin/metal cans can be dropped off at two locations. Take your used motor oil, car batteries, tires, and computers to the Gila County Landfill. The Humane Society collects aluminum cans all around town and used motor oil can be taken to an auto parts store (call first.)

Materials accepted at the drop-off sites:

- Plastic (PETE) Bottles—Narrow Neck (soda, water, etc. but no hazardous material containers)
- Plastic (HDPE) bottles & jugs-Narrow Neck (milk, water, juice, etc. but no hazardous material containers)
- Steel & Tin Cans, Non-Hazardous empty aerosol cans
- Milk cartons, drink boxes and such as items as may be approved by the Town.

Tips to Reduce Your Trash

- Compost kitchen waste and yard clippings.
- Use durable coffee mugs, cloth napkins or towels.
- Buy food in bulk to reduce packaging.
- Donate old magazines or surplus equipment.
- Reuse boxes and plastic bags.
- Turn empty jars into containers for leftover food.
- In the office, use the duplex option on your copier.
- Use the blank side of used office paper for scratch paper.
