NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF THE FEASIBILITY STUDY REPORT FOR THE 7th STREET & ARIZONA AVENUE WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) REGISTRY SITE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the Feasibility Study (FS) report for the 7th Street & Arizona Avenue WQARF Site in Tucson, Ariz. An FS is conducted to identify a remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving the established remedial objectives. Following the completion of the FS, ADEQ will prepare a proposed remedial action plan (PRAP) for the site. A notice will be issued and the public will have an opportunity to comment on the PRAP.

The 7th & Arizona Avenue WQARF site is generally bounded by 1st Street to the north, 4th Avenue to the east, 8th Street and the railroad to the south, and 10th Avenue to the west. The site consists of the former Oliver's Cleaners dry cleaning facility, now a parking lot and the associated downgradient perched aquifer (non-drinking water) groundwater that is contaminated with tetrachloroethene (PCE) and trichloroethene (TCE) over regulatory limits.
