

**NOTICE OF 60-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
16TH STREET AND CAMELBACK
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
DRAFT REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION (RI) REPORT
SOLICITATION OF REMEDIAL OBJECTIVES (RO)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has released the draft remedial investigation (RI) report for the 16th Street and Camelback Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404 (c)(1)(b)]. An RI is conducted to document the nature and extent of the contamination and the sources thereof; identify current and potential impacts to public health, welfare, and the environment; identify current and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state; and obtain and evaluate any other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions. Remedial objectives (RO) are solicited from the public to identify current and reasonably foreseeable future uses of land and waters of the state.

The 16th Street and Camelback WQARF site consists of plumes located in Phoenix. The plumes are bounded approximately by Camelback Road to the north, Highland Avenue to the south, 17th Street to the east, and 15th Street to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene, 1,2-dichloropropane and 1,2-dichloroethane.

Bethany Home Rd., Phoenix, during which all interested parties will be given an opportunity to comment on the draft RI report and provide input on the RO. All comments received will be compiled in a responsiveness summary to be included in the final RI report. **Comments must be postmarked or received by ADEQ no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2015.**
