

**NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
16TH STREET AND CAMELBACK
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
PROPOSED REMEDIAL OBJECTIVES (RO) REPORT**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the proposed remedial objectives (RO) report for the 16th Street and Camelback Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404(C)(1)(c)]. Proposed RO are the clean-up goals determined for a specific site. They are identified based upon information provided during the public meeting and public comment period for the draft remedial investigation (RI) report and any other information received, and consider current and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state.

The 16th Street and Camelback WQARF site consists of plumes located in Phoenix. The plumes are bounded approximately by Camelback Road to the north, Highland Avenue to the south, 17th Street to the east, and 15th Street to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene, 1,2-dichloropropane and 1,2-dichloroethane.
