PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE COMMENT PERIOD FOR THE START OF THE REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION AND FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE 16TH STREET AND CAMELBACK WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) REGISTRY SITE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has initiated a remedial investigation (RI) and feasibility study (FS) at this site and has available for review and comment an RI/FS scope of work, fact sheet and outline of a community involvement plan (CIP) (A.R.S. § 49-287.03). The 16th Street and Camelback WQARF site is bounded approximately to the north by Medlock Drive, to the south by Highland Avenue, to the east by 17th Street, and to the west by 15th Street in Phoenix.

The purpose of the RI/FS is to determine the extent and location of contamination in the groundwater at the site and examine appropriate measures for remediation or clean up. Under written agreement, ADEQ may authorize another party to implement the RI/FS. The site boundaries described are intended to provide the public with recent information regarding the estimated geographic extent of the currently known contamination. The actual extent of the contamination may differ; therefore, the geographic boundaries may change as new information becomes available. The site score is based on a review of available information about the presence of hazardous substances at the site. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare or the environment. The site score is 23 out of a possible 120.
