

**NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
EAST CENTRAL PHOENIX 38TH STREET AND INDIAN SCHOOL ROAD
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
PROPOSED REMEDIAL OBJECTIVES (RO) REPORT**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the proposed remedial objectives (RO) report for the East Central Phoenix (ECP) 38th Street and Indian School Road Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404(C)(1)(c)]. Proposed ROs are the clean-up goals determined for a specific site. They are identified based upon information provided during the public meeting and public comment period for the draft remedial investigation (RI) report and any other information received, and consider current and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state.

The ECP 38th Street and Indian School Road WQARF site consists of a plume located in Phoenix. The plume is bounded approximately by Indian School Road to the north, Picadilly Road to the south, 38th Street to the east, and 36th Street to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene (PCE).
