

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 30-DAY COMMENT PERIOD
7TH AVENUE AND BETHANY HOME ROAD
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN (PRAP)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the proposed remedial action plan (PRAP) for the 7th Avenue and Bethany Home Road Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-408(C)]. The PRAP documents the results of the remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) and identifies the proposed remedy and its estimated costs.

The 7th Avenue and Bethany Home Road WQARF site consists of a plume located in Phoenix. The plume is bounded approximately by W. Rose Lane to the north, W. Bethany Home Road to the south, N. 5th Avenue to the east, and N. 8th Avenue to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene, trichloroethene and vinyl chloride.

The proposed remedy for the site is as follows: In situ enhanced reductive de-chlorination with monitored natural attenuation. The estimated cost to implement this remedy is approximately \$2,102,000 for a period of fifteen years.
