

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 30-DAY COMMENT PERIOD
ESTES LANDFILL
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN (PRAP)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the proposed remedial action plan (PRAP) for the Estes Landfill Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-408(C)]. The PRAP documents the results of the remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) and identifies the proposed remedy and its estimated costs.

The Estes Landfill WQARF site consists of a plume located in Phoenix. The plume is bounded approximately by the Salt River to the north, Magnolia Street to the south, the Sky Harbor Expressway to the east, and S. 37th St. to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are vinyl chloride, cis-1,2-dichloroethene and trichloroethene in groundwater.

The proposed remedy for the site is plume remediation by monitored natural attenuation. The estimated cost to implement this remedy is approximately \$470,841 over a period of 15 years, averaging \$31,389 per year. Cleanup goals will likely be achieved in less than 15 years.
