NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF FEASIBILITY STUDY REPORT FOR THE WESTERN AVENUE WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND SITE (WQARF) REGISTRY SITE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the Feasibility Study (FS) report for the Western Avenue WQARF Site in Goodyear and Avondale, Ariz. An FS is conducted to identify a remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving the established remedial objectives. Following the completion of the FS, ADEQ will prepare a proposed remedial action plan (PRAP) for the site. A notice will be issued and the public will have an opportunity to comment on the PRAP.

The Western Avenue WQARF site is generally bounded on the north by San Xavier Boulevard, east to Third Street, south to State Route 85, and west to the Phoenix-Goodyear Airport (PGA)\Litchfield Road. The Western Avenue WQARF site was placed on the WQARF registry in December 1998. The score of this site is 51 out of a possible 120 points. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare of the environment.
