NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF FEASIBILITY STUDY REPORT FOR THE SOUTH MESA WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND SITE (WQARF) REGISTRY SITE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the Feasibility Study (FS) report for the South Mesa WQARF Site in Gilbert and Mesa, Ariz. An FS is conducted to identify a remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving the established remedial objectives. Following the completion of the FS, ADEQ will prepare a proposed remedial action plan (PRAP) for the site. A notice will be issued and the public will have an opportunity to comment on the PRAP.

The South Mesa WQARF site is generally bounded on the south and west by railroad tracks, on the east by Cooper/Stapley Road, and on the north by Broadway Road. The South Mesa WQARF site was placed on the WQARF Registry in August 1998. The score of this site is 26 out of a possible 120 points. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare of the environment.
