

**NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
COOPER ROAD AND COMMERCE AVENUE  
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE  
PROPOSED REMEDIAL OBJECTIVES (RO) REPORT**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the proposed remedial objectives (RO) report for the Cooper Road and Commerce Avenue Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Gilbert, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404(C)(1)(c)]. Proposed RO are the clean-up goals determined for a specific site. They are identified based upon information provided during the public meeting and public comment period for the draft remedial investigation (RI) report and any other information received, and consider current and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state.

The Cooper Road and Commerce Avenue WQARF site consists of a plume located in Gilbert. The plume is bounded approximately by Encinas Street to the north, Neely Ranch Preserve to the south, Neely Street to the east, and Ocotillo Drive to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene (PCE) and trichloroethene (TCE).
