**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY
WEST CENTRAL PHOENIX EAST GRAND AVENUE
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS) WORK PLAN**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has approved the feasibility study (FS) work plan to implement the FS for the West Central Phoenix East Grand Avenue Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404(C)(1)(d)]. An FS is conducted to identify a reference remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving established remedial objectives and to evaluate them based on the comparison criteria to select a remedy.

The West Central Phoenix East Grand Avenue WQARF site consists of a plume located in Phoenix. The plume is bounded approximately by Whitton Avenue to the north, Earll Drive to the south, 27th Avenue to the east, and 33rd Avenue to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene, trichloroethene and 1,1-dichloroethene.
