

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 30-DAY COMMENT PERIOD
SOUTH MESA
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN (PRAP)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the proposed remedial action plan (PRAP) for the South Mesa Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Mesa, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-408(C)]. The PRAP documents the results of the remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) and identifies the proposed remedy and its estimated costs.

The South Mesa WQARF site consists of a plume located in Mesa. The plume is bounded approximately by Broadway Road to the north, Southern Pacific Company to the south, Stapley/Cooper to the east, and Union Pacific Railroad to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethylene (PCE), trichloroethylene (TCE) and cis 1,2- dichloroethene.

The proposed remedy for the site is Monitored Natural Attenuation. This remedy is performed by routinely monitoring the natural reduction/breakdown of contaminants in the environment. The estimated cost of the remedy is approximately \$255,000.00 for a period of five (5) years.
