

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY  
WEST CENTRAL PHOENIX (WCP) WEST GRAND AVENUE  
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE  
RECORD OF DECISION (ROD)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has issued a record of decision (ROD), which is deemed a final administrative decision as defined by Arizona Revised Statutes § 41-1092 for the WCP West Grand Avenue WQARF site in Phoenix, Arizona. The ROD contains a description of the remedy, a responsiveness summary regarding all comments received on the proposed remedial action plan, a time for completing the remedy and total estimated cost.

The WCP West Grand Avenue WQARF site consists of a plume located in Phoenix. The plume is bounded approximately by Osborn Road to the north, Earll Drive to the south, 33rd Avenue to the east, and 34th Drive to the west. The contaminant of concern at the site is trichloroethene (TCE).
