NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF THE FEASIBILITY STUDY WORK PLAN FOR THE
WEST CENTRAL PHOENIX, WEST GRAND AVENUE WATER QUALITY
ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) REGISTRY SITE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has prepared the feasibility study work plan to implement the feasibility study for the West Central Phoenix (WCP) West Grand Avenue (WGA) WQARF Site in Phoenix, Arizona (A.A.C. R18-16-404(C)(1)(d)). A feasibility study is conducted to identify a remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving the established remedial objectives.

The WCP WGA WQARF Site is bounded approximately W. Osborn Road to the north, 31st Avenue to the east, Thomas Road to the south and 35th Drive to the west in Phoenix, Arizona.

The WCP WGA WQARF Site was placed on the WQARF Registry in April 1998 with a score of 17 out of a possible 120. The Site score was re-evaluated in 2000 with a revised score of 22. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the Registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare or the environment.

Following the completion of the feasibility study as outlined in the work plan, ADEQ will prepare a proposed remedial action plan for the site. A notice will be issued and the public will have an opportunity to comment on the plan.
