

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY 20TH STREET AND FACTOR AVENUE WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE FINAL REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION (RI) REPORT

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the final remedial investigation (RI) report for the 20th Street and Factor Avenue Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Yuma, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-406(J)]. An RI is conducted to document the nature and extent of the contamination and the sources thereof; identify current and potential impacts to public health, welfare, and the environment; identify current and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state; and obtain and evaluate any other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions.

The final RI report includes the final remedial objectives report and responsiveness summaries regarding comments, issues and concerns raised during the community involvement process.

The 20th Street and Factor Avenue WQARF site consists of a plume located in Yuma. The plume is bounded to the north by 17th Street, to the south by 21st Street, to the east by Kennedy Lane, and to the west by 4th Avenue. The contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene, trichloroethene, 1,1-dichloroethene, cis 1,2-dichloroethene, cyanide, and di (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate.
