NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY OF THE FINAL GROUNDWATER OPERABLE
UNIT (GOU) REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION (RI) REPORT FOR THE BROADWAY-
PANTANO WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF)
REGISTRY SITE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the Final Groundwater Operable Unit (GOU) Remedial Investigation (RI) Report for the Broadway-Pantano WQARF Registry Site in Phoenix, Arizona (A.A.C. R18-16-406(J)). A GOU RI Report is prepared to identify the nature, extent, and sources of contaminated waters of the state; identify current and potential impacts to public health, welfare and the environment; identify present and reasonably foreseeable uses of waters of the state; and obtain and evaluate any other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions. The Final GOU RI Report includes the Final GOU Remedial Objectives (RO) Report and responsiveness summaries regarding comments, issues and concerns raised during the community involvement process.

The Broadway-Pantano WQARF Registry Site consists of a contaminated groundwater plume bounded approximately by Speedway Boulevard to the north, Pantano Wash to the east, Calle Madero to the south (south of Broadway Boulevard), and Van Buren Avenue to the west (west of Wilmot Road). The site consists of the closed municipal Broadway North Landfill (BNL), Broadway South Landfill (BSL) and the associated tetrachloroethene (PCE) contaminant plume. The site boundaries provide the estimated extent of currently known contamination. The current contaminants of concern in the groundwater include PCE, trichloroethene (TCE), and vinyl chloride. Contaminants of concern at the site may change as new data become available.

The Broadway-Pantano WQARF Registry Site was placed on the WQARF Registry in 1998 with a score of 48 out of a possible 120 points. The scoring of a site, its relative score, or its placement on the Registry does not necessarily represent a determination that the release of a hazardous substance from the site poses a threat to human health or welfare or the environment.
