Laura,

As ADEQ is aware, RID was prepared to submit its FS Report by the end of May 2014, but delayed submitting its FS Report until July 15, 2014 at the request of ADEQ in order to "facilitate" ADEQ's review of both FS Reports. It now has been over 70 calendar days since the FS Reports were submitted, and RID has yet to receive an "administrative completeness determination" from ADEQ. Prior to ADEQ's repeal of the prior licensing time frames for WQARF "administrative completeness determinations," such determinations were to be completed in no more than 21 business days, or approximately 30 calendar days. Every day of delay results in increased contamination of RID's water supply and increased remediation costs incurred by RID.

As a means to "facilitate" ADEQ's "administrative completeness determination" for RID's FS Report, RID submitted, as an appendage to its transmittal letter and FS Report, the specific information required for ADEQ approval pursuant to AAC R18-16-413. To "facilitate" ADEQ's review of the Working Group's FS Report, RID submitted correspondence to ADEQ on July 16, 2014 and August 12, 2014 that specifically identified significant deficiencies that make the Working Group's FS Report "administratively incomplete" and not entitled to further review by ADEQ. In short, RID is not aware of any reason why ADEQ has been unable over the last 70 days to "facilitate" its "administrative completeness determination" for both FS Reports as previously committed by ADEQ.

Please advise why RID is being subjected to this unreasonable delay.
