## EXTENSION OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD WEST VAN BUREN WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS)

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is extending the public comment period for the Roosevelt Irrigation District (RID) and the West Van Buren Working Group (WVBWG) feasibility study (FS) reports for the West Van Buren Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona until January 14, 2015. An FS is conducted to identify a reference remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving established remedial objectives and to evaluate them based on the comparison criteria to select a remedy.

The West Van Buren WQARF site consists of a plume located in Phoenix. The plume is bounded approximately by West McDowell Road to the north, West Lower Buckeye Road to the south, 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the east, and 75<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the west. In addition, a separate, finger shaped plume exists from approximately West Buckeye Road and South 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue to West Watkins Street and South 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue and is also associated with the regional contaminant plume. Contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), 1,1,1-trichloroethene (1,1-DCA), *cis*-1,2-dichloroethene (*cis*-1,2-DCE), 1,1-dichloroethene (1,1-DCE), and chromium.
