

PUBLIC NOTICE
OF
PROPOSED SOIL AND GROUNDWATER CLEANUP

In accordance with Arizona Administrative Code R18-12-264.01, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice that a Revised Corrective Action Plan (CAP) has been proposed for the remediation (i.e., cleanup) of soils and groundwater that have been contaminated with petroleum as a result of a leaking Underground Storage Tank (UST) system at the following facility:

Soil Vapor Extraction and Air Sparge System, and Natural Attenuation:

Existing soil contamination at the referenced site will be remediated using an active soil vapor extraction and air sparge system. During soil vapor extraction, vapors are extracted from the contaminated area and treated. In air sparging, air is injected into contaminated groundwater to volatilize the contaminants, which are recovered and treated at the surface, if required by the applicable laws. To evaluate the effectiveness of the systems, periodic monitoring of the contaminant levels will be required by ADEQ. After the source of contamination is removed, soil and groundwater will continue to be remediated using natural attenuation. In the natural attenuation process, existing bacteria at the site consume contaminants as their food source, periodic monitoring of contaminant levels will be required by ADEQ. Once contaminate levels decrease to below cleanup standards, the site may be eligible for closure.

A copy of the CAP is available for review during normal business hours at the ADEQ Records and Library Review Area, 1110 W. Washington Street, Suite 140, Phoenix, AZ 85007 and the Parker Public Library at 1001 South Navajo Avenue, Parker, AZ 85344. ADEQ encourages public participation in UST corrective actions and welcomes comments on the proposed CAP. A public comment period is in effect from December 1, 2004 through January 7, 2005. Comments should be submitted in writing to ADEQ/TPD Corrective Action Section/SIRU I Unit, Attention: Lauren Evans, 1110 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If sufficient public interest has been demonstrated during the public comment period, ADEQ will announce and hold a public meeting.
