

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED SOIL AND GROUNDWATER CLEANUP

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes § 49-1005.H and Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations § 280.67, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice that a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) has been proposed for the remediation (i.e., cleanup) of soils and groundwater that have been contaminated with petroleum as a result of a leaking Underground Storage Tank (UST) system at the following facility:

Soil Vapor Extraction:

Existing soil contamination at the referenced site will be remediated using an active soil vapor extraction (SVE) system. During soil vapor extraction, vapors are extracted from the contaminated area and treated, if required by applicable law. To evaluate the effectiveness of SVE, periodic monitoring of contaminant levels will be required by ADEQ. Once contaminant levels decrease to below cleanup standards, the site may be eligible for closure.

Air Sparging System:

Existing groundwater contamination at the referenced site will be remediated using an air sparging system. During air sparging, air is injected into contaminated groundwater to volatilize the contaminants, which are recovered and treated at the surface, if required by applicable law. To evaluate the effectiveness of air sparging, periodic monitoring of contaminant levels will be required by ADEQ. Once contaminant levels decrease to below cleanup standards, the site may be eligible for closure.

A copy of the CAP is available for review during normal business hours at the ADEQ Records and Library Review Area, 1110 W. Washington Street, Ste. 140, Phoenix, AZ 85007 and the Lake Havasu Library 1770 N. McCulloch Blvd, Lake Havasu City, AZ 86403. ADEQ encourages public participation in UST corrective actions and welcomes comments on the proposed CAP. A public comment period is in effect from July 21, 2004 until August 27, 2004. Comments should be submitted in writing by August 27, 2004 to ADEQ/UST Corrective Action Section/SIRU 1, Attention: Tim Levandowsky, 1110 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If sufficient public interest has been demonstrated during the comment period, ADEQ will announce and hold a public meeting.
