

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED SOIL AND GROUNDWATER CLEANUP

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes 49-1005.H and Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations 280.67, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice that a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) has been proposed for the remediation (i.e., cleanup) of soils and groundwater that have been contaminated with petroleum as a result of a leaking Underground Storage Tank (UST) system at the following facility:

Remediation Method(s):

Aerobic Natural Attenuation

Groundwater contamination at the referenced site will be remediated using oxygen release substances. During the remedial process these oxygen release substances will be added to enhance aerobic degradation of petroleum hydrocarbons. To evaluate the effectiveness of the aerobic remediation, periodic monitoring of contaminant levels will be required by ADEQ. Once contaminant levels decrease to below cleanup standards, the site will be eligible for closure.

A copy of the CAP is available for review during normal business hours at the ADEQ Records and Library Review Area, 1110 W. Washington Street, Ste. 140, Phoenix, AZ 85007 and the Coolidge Public Library, 160 West Central Avenue, Coolidge, AZ 85228-4406. ADEQ encourages public participation in UST corrective actions and welcomes comments on the proposed CAP. A public comment period is in effect from November 10, 2004 until December 17, 2004. Comments should be submitted in writing by December 17, 2004 to ADEQ/UST/ SIRU II, Attention: Niles Keeran, 1110 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If sufficient public interest has been demonstrated within 30 days of this notice, ADEQ will announce and hold a public meeting.
