

## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED SOIL AND GROUNDWATER CLEANUP**

In accordance with Arizona Administrative Code R18-12-264.01, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice that a Corrective Action Plan (CAP), submitted by WYO Corporation dated March 1, 2005, has been proposed for the remediation (i.e. cleanup) of soils and groundwater that have been contaminated with petroleum as a result of a leaking Underground Storage Tank (UST) system at the following facility:

### **Soil Vapor Extraction and Air Sparge System:**

Existing soil and groundwater contamination at the referenced site will be remediated using an active soil vapor extraction and air sparge system. During soil vapor extraction, vapors are extracted from the contaminated area and treated. In air sparging, air is injected into contaminated groundwater to volatilize the contaminants, which are recovered and treated at the surface, if required by the applicable laws. To evaluate the effectiveness of the systems, periodic monitoring of contaminant levels will be required by ADEQ. Once contaminant levels decrease to below cleanup standards, the site may be eligible for closure.

A copy of the CAP is available for review during normal business hours at the ADEQ Records and Library Review Area, 1110 W. Washington Street, Ste. 140, Phoenix, AZ 85007 and at The Kingman Public Library, 3269 North Burbank Street, Kingman, Arizona. 86401. ADEQ encourages public participation in UST corrective actions and welcomes comments on the proposed CAP. A public comment period is in effect from August 22, 2005 through September 26, 2005. Comments should be submitted in writing by September 28, 2005, to ADEQ/TPD Corrective Action Section Site and Remediation Unit I, Attention: Samuel Rogers, 1110 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If sufficient public interest has been demonstrated during the public comment period, ADEQ will announce and hold a public meeting.
