

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED SOIL  
AND GROUNDWATER CLEANUP**

In accordance with Arizona Administrative Code R18-12-264.01, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) is providing notice that a Revised Corrective Action Plan (CAP), submitted by CEMEX USA on December 9, 2003, has been proposed for the remediation (i.e. cleanup) of soils and groundwater that have been contaminated with petroleum as a result of a leaking Underground Storage Tank (UST) system at the following facility:

**Bioremediation:**

Soil and groundwater contamination at the referenced site will be remediated by using active bioremediation. During active bioremediation, the existing or added bacteria use contaminants as their food source, eventually eliminating contaminants from the site. Additional chemicals may be added to groundwater to aid the bacteria in metabolizing the contaminants. To evaluate the effectiveness of active bioremediation, periodic monitoring of contaminant levels will be required by ADEQ. Once contaminant levels decrease to below cleanup standards, the site may be eligible for closure.

A copy of the CAP is available for review during normal business hours at the ADEQ Records and Library Review Area, 1110 W. Washington Street, Ste. 140, Phoenix, AZ 85007 and at the Avondale Public Library located at 328 W. Western Avenue, Avondale, AZ 85323. ADEQ encourages public participation in UST corrective actions and welcomes comments on the proposed CAP. A public comment period is in effect from August 25, 2004 through October 1, 2004. Comments should be submitted in writing to ADEQ/TPD Corrective Action Section/LUST Enforcement Unit, Attention: Lauren Evans, 1110 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If sufficient public interest has been demonstrated during the public comment period, ADEQ will announce and hold a public meeting.
