**BACKGROUND**

A significant time lag may exist between the approval of a site characterization report and the submittal of a corrective action plan (CAP) or a remediation pre-approval work plan. To adequately review the proposed remediation methodology, it is important that ADEQ has current soil and or groundwater analytical results to ensure that the proposed correctives actions meet the requirements of A.R.S. § 49-1005(D).

**CONTENT**

“Before submitting a corrective action plan (CAP) or a remediation pre-approval work plan to ADEQ, it may be reasonable and cost effective to collect additional soil and/or groundwater samples if the last analytical results are not current and may not reflect current site conditions. A facility meeting can be requested to discuss this issue with the Department.”

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
