TRAINING OBJECTIVE

The Drinking Water Section will conduct a single-day seven-hour workshop and three one and one-half day twelve 12-hour workshops on emergency management planning for facility owners and operators of drinking water and wastewater systems and for public and industrial and critical infrastructure entities in Arizona communities. The workshops will provide updates on protocols and procedures for all federal, state, tribal and local responders to coordinate emergency response statewide.
