

## Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule

### Intent to Grandfather Notice

A public water system (PWS) that will submit grandfathered *Cryptosporidium* data for the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule (LT2ESWTR) must first submit a notice that the system intends to submit previously collected *Cryptosporidium* monitoring results (see table below for notice of intent submittal due dates). This notice must specify the number of previously collected results that the system will submit, the dates of the first and last sample, and whether the system will collect additional source water monitoring samples to meet the requirements of the rule. If a PWS plans to collect additional samples, the system must also submit a monitoring schedule. Submitting this form satisfies the requirement to submit a notice of intent to grandfather.
