ADEQ Staff to Discuss Brownfields Funding at Seven Seminars Throughout the State at end of February

PHOENIX (Feb. 13, 2012) – Arizona Department of Environmental Quality staff will be participating in a series of seven workshops around the state later this month to discuss ADEQ’s Brownfields and underground storage tanks remediation funding opportunities.

The ADEQ presentations will be part of the Center for Creative Land Recycling’s (CCLR) seminars to inform rural communities of possible federal and state grant and loan money available for town improvements.

“This is a very good venue to explain how our programs can help revitalize communities and explain the process to all of those interested,” said ADEQ Director Henry Darwin.
