Free Electronic Waste Recycling Events to be Held in Kingman, Bullhead City, Lake Havasu City on March 2

PHOENIX (Feb. 19, 2013) — Arizona Department of Environmental Quality officials announced today that residents of Kingman, Bullhead City and Lake Havasu City can dispose of their stockpiles of electronics waste for free during events on Saturday, March 2 from 8 a.m. until noon.

The Kingman event will be held on the Mohave Community College Neal Campus-Kingman near Building 500, 1971 Jagerson Ave. The Bullhead City event will be held at Bullhead City Public Works Annex, 1285 Alona's Way. The Lake Havasu City event will be held in the parking lot near Building 500 at the MCC campus, 1977 Acoma Blvd. West.

The events, which are sponsored by ADEQ, the Mohave Community College Computer Club MC4, and Westech Recyclers of Phoenix, are expected to collect tons of TVs, computers, monitors, cell phones, chargers, VCRs, CD and DVD players, fax machines and cables and cords.

“This is another example of free services that ADEQ, MC4 and Westech Recyclers are providing to Mohave County residents,” said ADEQ Director Henry Darwin. “People can get rid of their potentially toxic stream of waste in a number of areas at these events and protect Arizona’s public health and environment.”
