

**PROPOSED ARIZONA POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (AZPDES)
PERMIT MAJOR MODIFICATION**

Pursuant to the Clean Water Act and in accordance with Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-9-B906, the Director of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) proposes to issue a major modification to an Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AZPDES) Permit to discharge pollutants to Waters of the United States to the following applicant, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions:

The Town of Buckeye applied for a major modification to their AZPDES permit for the Central Buckeye WWTP to include two additional outfalls (003 and 004) from the facility to the Roosevelt Irrigation District (RID) Canal and Buckeye Canal, in the Middle Gila River Basin in Township 1 N, Range 3W, Section 13 and 35, in Maricopa County, Arizona. The Wastewater Treatment Plant is a publicly owned treatment works that receives domestic wastewater from residential and commercial sources in the Town of Buckeye. This modification does not increase the design capacity of the facility. Sludge is treated in aerobic digesters before de-watering on site and then hauled and disposed of at Southwest Regional Landfill in Buckeye, Arizona.

Persons may submit comments or request a public hearing on the proposed action in writing, to Richard Mendolia, Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division, 1110 W. Washington St., 5415B-3, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. All written comments received by ADEQ by the close of business on the date 30 days after publication of this notice will be considered in the final permit decision. A public hearing request must be in writing and must include the reasons for such request. If there is a significant degree of public interest, the Director will hold a hearing in accordance with A.A.C. R18-9-A908(B).
