

- “Low-income communities and communities of color already overburdened with pollution are likely to be disproportionately affected by, and less resilient to, the impacts of climate change.” [CPP NFRM Pre-Pub IX, at 1313]
- “The agency uses ‘vulnerable’ and ‘overburdened’ communities to refer to low-income, minority communities, and indigenous communities.” [EJ Screening Report, at 3, n. 1]
- Vulnerable communities are likely to benefit from rule [CPP NFRM Pre-Pub IX, at 1313-14]
- But localized emissions increases may occur as a result of shifts in generation; increases should generally occur at low-emitting NGCC; states encouraged to assess actual impacts [CPP NFRM Pre-Pub IX, at 1316]
