On December 27, 2012, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received a revision to the Arizona state implementation plan (SIP) from the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality. The SIP revision was submitted to address infrastructure elements found in section 110(a)(2) of the Clean Air Act (CAA) which are necessary to implement, maintain, and enforce the 2008 ozone national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) in Arizona. The EPA has determined that elements are complete with the following exceptions:

- 110(a)(2)(C) for Maricopa, Pima, and Pinal Counties (PSD portions)
- 110(a)(2)(D)(i)(II) for Maricopa, Pima, and Pinal Counties (PSD portions)
- 110(a)(2)(D)(ii) For Maricopa, Pima, and Pinal Counties (PSD portions)
- 110(a)(2)(J) for Maricopa, Pima, and Pinal Counties (PSD portions)
- 110(a)(2)(K) for Maricopa, Pima, and Pinal Counties (PSD portions)
