**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 30-DAY COMMENT PERIOD  
FORMER CAPITOL CASTINGS FACILITY  
VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM (VRP) SITE  
PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN (PRAP)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has released the Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) for the Former Capitol Castings Facility Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) Site in Tempe, Arizona (VRP Site #504426-00) [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-408(C)(2) and R18-16-404(C)(1)(e)].

The Former Capitol Castings Facility VRP Site consists of groundwater affected by 1,1-dichloroethene (1,1-DCE) located in Tempe, Arizona. The 1,1-DCE affected groundwater is bounded more or less by the southern boundary of the Former Capitol Castings Facility to the north, Western Canal to the east, Guadalupe Road to the south, and Kyrene Road to the west.

The PRAP summarizes the results of the Remedial Investigation (RI)/Feasibility Study (FS) and the plan for implementing the ADEQ-approved remedy. The RI/FS established continued groundwater monitoring as the remedy and controlled migration coupled with continued groundwater monitoring as the contingency remedy for the 1,1-DCE affected groundwater. The PRAP provides the details of the continued groundwater monitoring plan and the engineering design of the contingency remedy. Implementation of the PRAP would satisfy all the applicable requirements, including A.R.S. 49-282.06(A), and achieve the ADEQ-approved remedial objectives. These objectives are to protect against a loss or impairment of each municipal, agricultural, industrial or other beneficial use of groundwater pumped from certain supply wells that is threatened to be lost or impaired as a result of the 1,1-DCE, while such threat exists. The continued groundwater monitoring remedy is estimated to cost \$440,000 per 5 year period. The contingency remedy of controlled migration is estimated at \$2 million in capital costs and \$3.7 million per 5 year period of operation.
