NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO CORRECT DEFICIENCIES

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has reason to believe that the above referenced facility has failed to meet a requirement of the Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.), a rule within the Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.), or an applicable permit/license, as listed below.

The purpose of this document is to provide notice that ADEQ believes a violation of an environmental requirement has occurred. Additionally, it provides opportunity to: (1) request a meeting with ADEQ and discuss the facts surrounding the violation; (2) demonstrate to ADEQ that no violations have occurred; or (3) document that the violations have been corrected.

	1.	A.A.C. R18-13-303(A)	Placing, depositing, or allowing to be placed or deposited refuse or other objectionable waste on a person's premises or on any public street, road, or alley.	
	2.	A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(1)	Creation of a risk to public health or the environment by storing used/waste tires outdoors that exceeds twenty feet in height.	
	3.	A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(2)	Storage of used/waste tires outdoors in a manner that does not provide access routes between and around tire piles that are at least twenty feet wide and maintained free of accumulations of rubbish, equipment or other materials.	
	4.	A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(2)	Creation of a risk to public health or the environment by storing used motor vehicle tires outdoors in a grid system that exceeds fifty feet by one hundred fifty feet.	
	5.	A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(3)	Creation of a risk to public health or the environment by storing used/waste tires outdoors within three feet of any property line.	
	6.	A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(4)	Creation of a risk to public health or the environment by storing used/waste tires outdoors that exceeds six feet in height if the used/waste tires are stored between three and ten feet of any property line.	
	7.	A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(5)	Storage of used/waste tires outdoors within fifty feet of any area in which smoking of tobacco or any other substance is permitted.	

	8.	A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(7)	Storage of used/waste tires without placing class "2A-10BC" type fire extinguishers at well marked points throughout the storage area so that the travel distance from any point in the storage area to a fire extinguisher is not more than seventy-five feet.			
	9.	A.R.S. § 44-1303/ A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(8)	Failure of an owner or operator of a used/waste tire collection site to register with ADEQ.			
	10.	A.A.C. R18-13-1212	Failure of a person that stores more than 100 used/waste tires outdoors to pay an initial registration fee.			
	11.	A.R.S. § 49-762(1)	Failure of the owner or operator of a solid waste land disposal facility to obtain approval of a solid waste facility plan.			
	12.	A.R.S. § 49-762.07(F)(1)	Failure of solid waste facilities, other than landfills, to control wind dispersion and other surface dispersion so that the solid waste does not create a public nuisance.			
	13.	A.R.S. § 49-762.07(F)(1)	Failure of solid waste facilities, other than landfills, to regularly collect visible solid waste that is dispersed beyond the boundaries of the solid waste facility.			
	14.	A.R.S. § 49-803(A)(3)	Disposal of used oil on land in a manner other than disposal at a landfill regulated under 40 CFR Part 257 or 258 that has an approved solid waste facility plan.			
	15.	40 CFR § 279.22(b) / A.R.S. § 49-802(A)	Creation of a risk of release to soil by a failure to store used oil in containers that are in good condition that have no visible leaks.			
	16.	40 CFR § 279.22(c) / A.R.S. § 49-802(A)	Failure to properly label containers or above ground tanks or fill pipes used to store used oil at a generator facility.			
	17.	40 CFR § 279.22(d) / A.R.S. § 49-802(A)	Failure of a used oil generator to perform the required clean-up steps upon detection of a release of used oil to the environment.

Submitting Compliance Documentation						
Within calendar days of the date of this Notice, please submit documentation to the ADEQ contact above demonstrating that no violation has occurred or documentation that the alleged deficiency has been corrected. Acceptable documentation includes, but is not limited to photographs, receipts, standard operating procedures, and/or relevant logs.						

Once ADEQ has received the requested documentation, the case will be closed and a letter will be issued stating that the agency will take no further action as a result of this inspection.
