

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTRATION
OF SOLID WASTE FACILITIES
REQUIRING SELF-CERTIFICATION**

INSTRUCTIONS

New rules that are effective July 1, 2012, require the owner or operator of a regulated self-certification facility to register with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and submit to the Department specific information about the facility. Additionally, the rules require the payment of a registration fee and certification that the facility complies with state statutes and rules governing that type of facility¹.

Solid waste facilities requiring self-certification include²:

- A facility storing 5,000 or more waste tires on any one day and not required to obtain plan approval,
- Waste tire shredding and processing facilities, and
- Solid waste transfer facilities with a daily throughput of more than 180 cubic yards.

These facilities are required to comply with the self-certification procedures, registration and operational requirements.³ The attached registration form must be submitted for review and accepted by ADEQ.

The registration form requires the following:

- Applicant and facility identification,
- Key contact information,
- Information related to site activities,
- Information about the facility and the specific ways it will be or is designed and operated, and
- Documentation of other self-certification items as required by Arizona state law.

New Solid Waste Facilities: After July 1, 2012, new facilities must comply with registration requirements prior to construction.

Existing Solid Waste Facilities: Facilities in operation prior to July 1, 2012, must update their registration and pay the annual self-certification registration fee using this form.

Note Regarding Waste and Used Tires: Authorization to store used tires must be obtained by completing a *Registration of Outdoor Used Tire Sites (100 or More Used Tires)* form and paying the appropriate fee. A “waste tire” means a tire that is no longer suitable for its original intended purpose because of wear, damage or defect.⁴ A “used tire” is any tire that has been used for more than one day on a motor vehicle.⁵ A tire facility that must register under more than one program is only subject to one fee, which will be the greater of the two fees.⁶

GENERAL APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1) Applicant submits one copy of the registration form, including attachments, and the appropriate registration fee. **Note: The form must be submitted with an original signature.**
- 2) ADEQ reviews the form for completeness and informs the applicant of any deficiencies in writing.
- 3) Applicant addresses any deficiencies.
- 4) ADEQ notifies the applicant that the registration process is complete.
- 5) **Note:** If the registering facility is a facility storing 5,000 or more waste tires on any one day, it will also be issued a Waste Tire Collection Site Registration.

FEES

An initial fee is required along with your registration form.⁷ Fees for registration are:

- A facility storing 5,000 or more waste tires on any one day and not required to obtain plan approval:
\$1,000 for initial registration \$250 for annual registration thereafter
- Tire shredding/processing facility:
\$1,000 for initial registration \$250 for annual registration thereafter
- Solid waste transfer facility:
\$1,000 for initial registration \$500 for annual registration thereafter

- A certification statement indicating that the facility tire storage areas are in compliance with the National Electric Code (for any storage areas in which electrical wiring, fixtures, or appliances are present) [A.R.S. § 44-1304.01(A)(6)].

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S. § 41-1030):

- (1) ADEQ shall not base a licensing decision, in whole or in part, on a requirement or condition not specifically authorized by statute or rule. General authority in a statute does not authorize a requirement or condition unless a rule is made pursuant to it that specifically authorizes the requirement or condition.
- (2) Prohibited licensing decisions may be challenged in a private civil action. Relief may be awarded to the prevailing party against ADEQ, including reasonable attorney fees, damages, and all fees associated with the license application.
- (3) ADEQ employees may not intentionally or knowingly violate the requirement for specific licensing authority. Violation is cause for disciplinary action or dismissal, pursuant to ADEQ’s adopted personnel policy. ADEQ employees are still afforded the immunity in A.R.S. §§ 12-821.01 and 12-820.02.
