Re: Comments on the Roosevelt Irrigation District's ("RID") "Operation and Maintenance Plan"

Dear Danielle:

RID submitted an Operation & Maintenance Plan ("O&M Plan"), Revision 3, dated October 2013, to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ"). In its O&M Plan, RID references the four wells that it is treating as part of its Modified Early Response Action Work Plan that was conditionally approved by ADEQ on February 1, 2013. Those four wells – RID-89, RID-92, RID-95 and RID-114 – are drilled to different depths, have different pumping capacities and, because of their respective locations, treat groundwater of varying contaminant concentrations. Moreover, RID has installed different size and capacity wellhead treatment facilities on each of those wells that must therefore be monitored and maintained individually.

As a result of these pronounced differences, it is more logical to consider these four wellhead treatments as four separate treatment facilities requiring four separate O&M Plans.
