

NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF REMEDIAL OBJECTIVES FOR THE CENTRAL AND CAMELBACK WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-16-406.I, is soliciting Remedial Objectives (RO) for the Central and Camelback WQARF site. Proposed ROs are solicited from the public to identify current and reasonably foreseeable future uses of land and waters of the state. ROs, as defined in A.A.C. R18-16-401, include the following elements:

- Protection against the loss or impairment of identified uses of land and waters of the state;
- Restoration, replacement or otherwise providing for identified uses of land and waters of the state; and
- Time frames when action is needed to protect against or provide for the impairment or loss of the use.

The Central and Camelback WQARF site consists of contaminated groundwater plumes located in the vicinity of Central Avenue near Camelback Road in Phoenix. The plumes are bounded approximately by Georgia Avenue to the north, 2nd Street to the east, Mariposa Street to the south, and 1st Avenue to the west.

Bethany Home Rd., Phoenix. Proposals must be postmarked/received by ADEQ no later than 5 p.m. on July 28, 2014.
