NOTICE OF 60 DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON THE DRAFT REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION REPORT FOR THE CENTRAL AND CAMELBACK WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 49-287.03, has released the draft Remedial Investigation (RI) report for the Central and Camelback WQARF site in Phoenix, Ariz. An RI report is prepared to identify the nature and extent of contaminated soil and waters of the state and the sources thereof; identify current and potential impacts to public health, welfare and the environment; identify present and reasonably foreseeable future uses of the land and groundwater; and obtain and evaluate any other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions.

The Central and Camelback WQARF site consists of contaminated groundwater plumes located in the vicinity of Central Avenue near Camelback Road in Phoenix. The plumes are bounded approximately by Georgia Avenue to the north, 2nd Street to the east, Mariposa Street to the south, and 1st Avenue to the west.

A copy of the draft RI report will be available for review at the ADEQ office in Phoenix. With 24 hours notice, an appointment to review the public file is available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., at the ADEQ Records Center, 1110 W. Washington Street in Phoenix.
